Qantas and REX airlines are currently listed as the only airlines servicing Broken Hill. This may change closer to the RORT. Please check with your travel agent or airline for updated information.

Transport NSW offer the Xplorer train service leaving Sydney on Mondays at 6am and arriving in Broken Hill at 7:30pm. They also offer the XPT service daily to Dubbo with a coach service to Broken Hill.

Sydney, 13hours or 1150km - Brisbane 16.5 hours or 1550km - Melbourne 9hrs or 850km.

# 2025 APEX 40 RORT Venues

## Royal Flying Doctor Service

Located within a working RFDS base and airport, we can tour the base, view the aircraft in the hangar, explore the Mantle of Safety Museum, and watch a film in 44 seat theatre.



## Pro Hart Gallery

Pro Hart's art captures the lush colours, the sense of space and the spiritual quality of the outback in ways very few artists are able to emulate.

## Jack Absalom Gallery

Jack captures the true outback through his paintings. Jack was a member of the "Brushmen of the Bush" a group of 5 artists that exhibited in Australia and all over the world.

## Living Desert Sculptures



J Lawrence Beck, a Gosford based sculptor, designed the sculpture to Broken Hill's art culture. Using 53 tonnes of sandstone to create the "Living Desert Sculptures".

## The Palace Hotel

The Palace Hotel Broken Hill was used as a film set in the 1994 Australian iconic movie, Priscilla Queen of the Desert. The building was erected as a coffee palace in by The Temperance Movement. This is the pub with all the murals inside.



## Albert Kerston Mining & Minerals Museum



Also known as the GeoCentre, represents the extensive mineral history of Broken Hill. This geological science museum boasts a 42kg silver nugget as well as a large mineral collection, and it is home to the Silver Tree. At the museum you can explore all aspects of Broken Hill's unique geology, as well as the earth sciences of mineralogy and metallurgy.



## Town of Silverton

Located about 20 minutes from Broken Hill, Silverton is a historic community where the streets are dominated by galleries of all shapes and sizes. Silverton is a mecca for artists, photographers and their admirers.

Some say the draw card is the outback landscape, rich in colour and boundless beauty, while others are inspired by the serenity. The film industry is a major part of Silverton's identity having played host to many classics throughout the years including Mad Max. The Silverton Pub is also a famous watering hole.



## Silver City Mint & Art Centre

The Silver City Mint & Art Centre has a lot going for it. An art gallery, silversmiths and chocolate factory all rolled into one. For those who have not ventured into the Broken Hill Mint - it contains a huge diorama: it is completely landscaped to bring the outdoors indoors - you will be amazed.



## Railway & Historical Museum



The Sulphide Street Railway & Historical Museum Complex houses the Silverton Tramway Company locomotives & memorabilia in the original 1905 magnificent station building and grounds. The Broken Hill Migrant Heritage Museum, Hospital Museum, Ron Carter Transport Pavilion and the Tess Alfonsi Mineral Collection are all onsite.

## Synagogue of the Outback Museum



Broken Hill boasts one of the most remote Jewish museums in the world and the building which stands proudly in the former Synagogue as a reminder of the evolution of the Jewish community in regional Australia.
